GLOBAL VIRTUAL CONFERENCE ON GIRLS EDUCATION AND EQUITY

BFN aims to host global virtual conferences that will bring together leaders, change makers and participants across the world to advance dialogue on inclusive and equitable education and empowerment. The conference is to represent a key milestone in amplifying advocacy, awareness, and collaborative action.



SHE WHO BUILDS SKILLS/ STEAM EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM

The She Who Builds Skills Empowerment Program is a capacity-building initiative designed to equip 20 girls with practical, income-generating skills, confidence, and access to opportunities that promote self-reliance and long-term economic empowerment.

So far, we have developed the program framework, identified priority skill areas (STEAM), and begun engaging potential facilitators and partners. We are currently at the planning and resource-mobilization stage, finalizing training modules, timelines, and beneficiary selection criteria.

Execution will involve structured hands-on training sessions, mentorship, and post-training support, delivered through a mix of physical workshops and community-based learning. The program will be implemented in phases to ensure quality, monitoring, and measurable impact.

At present, the major factors holding us back are limited funding and the need for stronger strategic partnerships to support scale and sustainability.



MOBILITY AND PROSTHETICS SUPPORT PROGRAM

BFN plans to launch a support program aimed at restoring dignity, confidence, mobility and independence to people who are differently abled. Through the Mobility and Prosthetics Support Program, the Foundation intends to provide up to 25 prosthetic limbs (arms and legs) to young people who have been denied mobility, helping them regain movement, hope, and self-worth.

This initiative is being developed with the support of a Chinese company committed to humanitarian impact and inclusive care. While this partnership forms a strong foundation for the program, there is significant room for additional sponsorship and collaboration to expand reach, enhance quality, and ensure sustainability.

By supporting 25 individuals, this program goes beyond physical mobility; it restores purpose, renews confidence, and empowers beneficiaries to actively participate in their families, communities, and livelihoods. Through strategic partnerships and shared compassion, we aim to turn limitation into possibility and disability into ability.



FEMALE HEALTH, DIGNITY, AND PROTECTION PROJECT (SOUTH SUDAN)

Women and children in South Sudan continue to face extreme risks due to the ongoing crisis, with many losing their lives to preventable health complications and lack of support. In response, we plan to implement the Female Health, Dignity, and Protection Project, a targeted initiative aimed at safeguarding the well-being of women and girls while restoring their dignity.

The program will provide:

- **Maternal Health Support:** Essential childbirth materials and resources to ensure safer pregnancies and deliveries.
- **Child Health Support:** Vaccination programs and general health assistance to protect the lives of children.
- **Psychosocial Support:** Counseling and care for girls affected by female genital mutilation (FGM) and other traumatic experiences.
- **Health and Dignity Materials:** Provision of sanitary, menstrual, sexual, and reproductive health resources to promote hygiene, safety, and self-respect.

Through this intervention, we aim to reduce preventable deaths, empower women and girls, and strengthen community resilience in South Sudan.



EDUCATION ACCESS AND COMMUNITY SCHOOL SUPPORT PROGRAM

During the She Who Builds Campaign, we visited Community Secondary School, Umuozuche (Igbodo) in Etche Local Government Area of Rivers State and observed that the learning environment is severely dilapidated and unfit for students. The classrooms and facilities are in a state of disrepair, creating unsafe conditions that hinder effective teaching and learning.

In response, we plan to collaborate closely with the Local Government Chairman to ensure urgent attention is given to renovating the school infrastructure and creating a safe, conducive learning environment for all students. We will advocate formally and engage stakeholders to secure commitment and followthrough on this objective.

Additionally, as part of our impact strategy, we intend to provide university scholarship to top 30 performing students, prioritizing those from lowincome backgrounds who would otherwise struggle to access tertiary education. This initiative is designed to celebrate academic excellence and expand opportunities for deserving young people in the community.

In summary, through advocacy, partnership, and targeted support, we aim to transform the school environment and open pathways to safer learning spaces to students in these underserved communities .



SHE WHO BUILDS SKILLS EMPOWERMENT CONFERENCE



To celebrate a year of successful activities, BFN plans to host the BFN Empowerment and Award Conference at the end of the year as a culminating event to celebrate impact and transition beneficiaries into the next phase of growth. The conference is designed to bring together partners and to celebrate the BFN Scholarship and empowerment beneficiaries.

The event will feature a structured Award and certificate presentations, skills exhibitions, and recognition of outstanding participants. It will also include keynote sessions, mentorship talks, and panel discussions focused on career pathways, entrepreneurship, financial literacy, and personal development.

Beyond mentorship, the conference is intended to connect the girls to opportunities by facilitating linkages to mentors, employers, partners, and potential sponsors.
